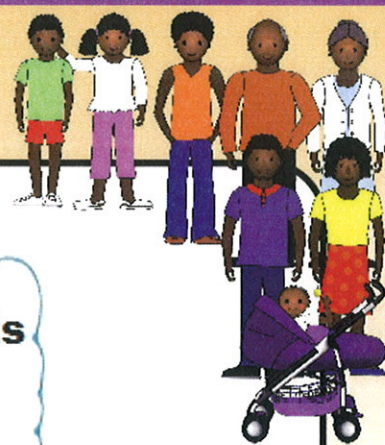
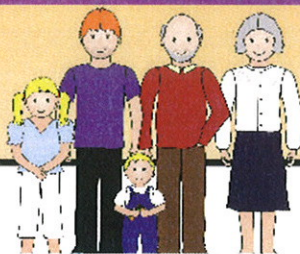
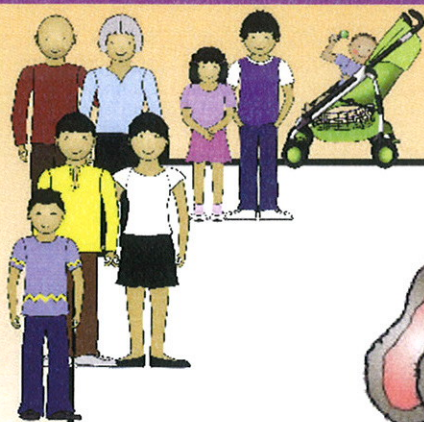




Eager Elephants Newsletter May 2014

We had Fire Fighters uniforms on, met with Firefighters and saw their equipment. We also had a trip around Kidzania in a Fire Engine. After that we went to a Hospital and met a Nurse and Doctor who showed us how to take care of newborn babies. We loved every step of the way. For some of our children a school bus drive was an experience all on its own. This week we learnt about the number 19, which was the number of the week and the letter S was our letter of the week.
