May Newsletter FS-2 and FS-1 Term 3



In May the FS1 children learned their letters: U u, V v, W w and X x and words that start with each sound. We have learned how to read our friends' names and the following words: (I, go to, the, and, Mum, Dad, Chip, Biff, Kipper and Floppy). This month we have been practicing our new songs: It's a beautiful day and Friends Forever. We are going to sing them during the graduation day in June. In Math we recognized numbers up to 20 and we counted together until 30. We learned more about patterns and objects that are the same or different.

FS 2 children blended sounds and read stories with different vowels: a, e, i, o, u. We wrote words and simple sentences and helped our FS1 friends in blending sounds. Together with FS 1 children we have been preparing for our graduation. In Math we wrote numbers to 50 and above and reviewed the concepts learned throughout the year: addition, subtraction, 3 D shapes, time, and measurements.

This month we have learned all about seasons (FS2): and community helpers in (FS1). In FS2 we wrote the names of the seasons and matched the clothes with each season.
