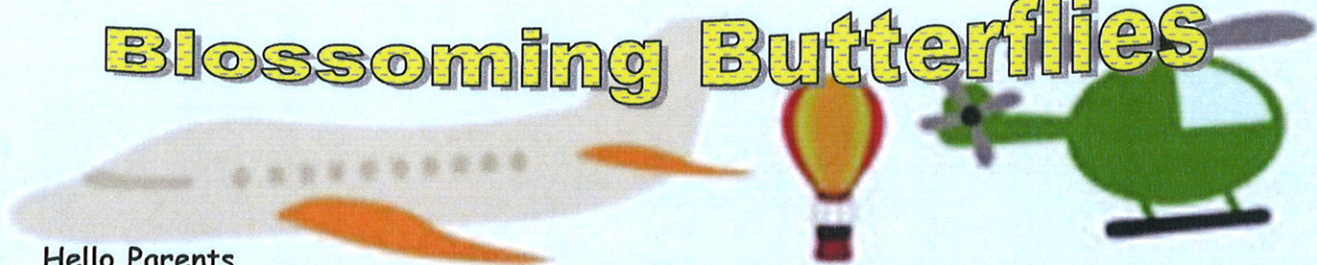

Our exercises enabled the children to familiarize the theme of the month which was "transportation".



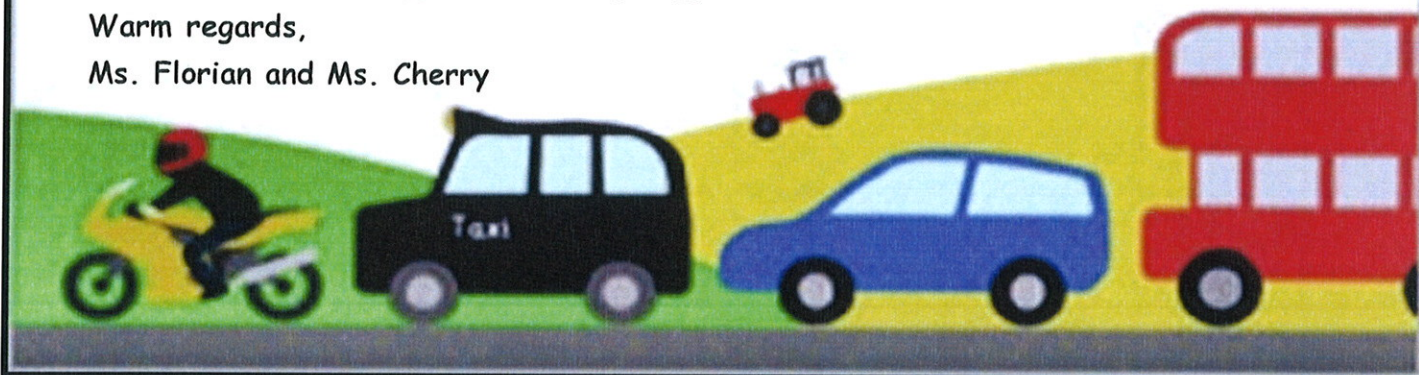
For March we will be concentrating on 'the Garden', letters "L & M", colour "Blue", numbers "3 & 4" and the shape "square"

We would like to extend our heartiest congratulations to Taasha who is now a proud BIG Sister.

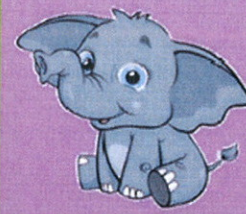
